GENERAL DYNAMICS UK IS A LEADING PRIME CONTRACTOR AND COMPLEX SYSTEMS INTEGRATOR WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH GOVERNMENT, MILITARY AND CIVIL FORCES AND PRIVATE COMPANIES AROUND THE WORLD.



WHILE AT GENERAL DYNAMICS UK, MR. JOHNSON WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND SUCCESSFUL DELIVERY OF THE \$ 5 B BOWMAN TACTICAL COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM TO THE UK ARMED FORCES. MR.
